We remember and celebrate Modesto "Morey" Navarro, who passed away on Monday, March 4, 2024 at the age of 73.

Morey was born on January 2, 1951 in Tepatitlan, Jalisco, Mexico to Esteban and Celia Navarro, the oldest of 8 siblings. In 1962 he moved to Oxnard, CA where he would reside for the remainder of his life.

He attended Our Lady of Guadalupe then Santa Clara High School and Ventura College. In 1971 Morey started Oxnard Towing until his retirement in 2005. He loved taking road trips with his family and spending time with his grand-dogs. Aside from his love of family, he was passionate about giving back. He was very involved in the community, always helping at his Alma mater, Santa Clara was proud to be a part of the Oxnard Planning Commission.
